RESOLUTION NO. 2013082

RE: OPPOSING THE PROCESS OF ENACTMENT AND CERTAIN PROVISIONS CONTAINED WITHIN THE NEW YORK SAFE ACT

Legislators WEISS, FORMAN, HORTON, INCORONATO, KELSEY, TRAUDT, ROLISON, BORCHERT, FLESLAND, BOLNER, HUTCHINGS, MICCIO, ROMAN, SERINO, SURMAN, THOMES, and WILKINSON offer the following and move its adoption:

WHEREAS, December 14, 2012, in Newtown, Connecticut, was a watershed moment in American life. The thought that young children were not safe from harm while attending their first grade class should be a call to action in our society; and

WHEREAS, this call to action should start with dialogue among the affected members of our society and should focus on the primary issues revolving around this tragedy, namely school security, mental health and the access to weapons that are currently available to the mentally ill; and

WHEREAS, shortly thereafter and partly in response to this tragedy, Chapter 1 of the Laws of 2013, known as the New York Secure Ammunition and Firearms Enforcement (NY SAFE) Act was adopted after minimal public discussion or input from stakeholders; and

WHEREAS, the lawful ownership of firearms is, and has been, a valued tradition in the United States, and the rights protected by the Second Amendment to the United States Constitution are exercised by many Dutchess County Residents; and

WHEREAS, the NY SAFE Act (Chapter 1 of the Laws of 2013) has engendered significant controversy over both the process by which it was enacted and certain provisions contained within it; and

WHEREAS, the expedited process of crafting the NY SAFE Act completely circumvented the transparency that the residents of Dutchess County and the State of New York are entitled to with respect to such a complex issue and has resulted in complex policy changes, many of which have been left up to interpretation; and

WHEREAS, the passage of the NY SAFE Act will have a detrimental effect on hunters, sportsmen and legal gun owners; and

WHEREAS, the NY SAFE Act expressly states that no costs of the law should be borne by the local governments, however many Dutchess County Departments, such as the Department of Mental Hygiene, the Dutchess County Clerk and the Dutchess County Sheriff's Office will experience increased workload and costs associated with the new requirements that the law creates; and

WHEREAS, the United States Supreme Court in the matter of the District of Columbia v. Heller, 554 US 570 (2008) found that an individual's right to keep and bear arms was inherent in the language of the Second Amendment to the United States Constitution confirming that states and federal districts may not take unreasonable steps to deny the Second Amendment right to citizens of the United States through onerous permitting processes; and the United States Supreme Court in McDonald v. Chicago, 561 US 325 (2010) held that the Second Amendment was binding on the States and that the right of an individual to keep and bear arms was protected by the Second Amendment and incorporated by the due process clause of the Fourteenth Amendment; and

WHEREAS, there are some areas in the NY SAFE Act Legislation that the Dutchess County Legislature finds encouraging, such as addressing the primary short comings of the mental health system, the strengthening of Kendra's Law and Mark's Law, as well as privacy protections for pistol permit holders, however the legislation negatively impacts local gun ownership; and

WHEREAS, the Legislation fails to offer any meaningful solution to the gun violence that it was intended to address and places increased burdens where they do not belong, upon law abiding citizens; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Dutchess County Legislature on behalf of all the people of Dutchess County strongly encourages members of the New York State Legislature to hold public hearings to address the impact of this new law and the issue of gun violence in a way that will produce meaningful results; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Dutchess County Legislature calls upon the New York State Legislature and Governor Andrew M. Cuomo to work with counties to repeal and revise the NY SAFE Act in order to address concerns expressed herein; specifically limiting or eliminating any additional cost to county government, and be it further

RESOLVED, the Clerk of the Dutchess County Legislature is hereby authorized and directed to forward copy of this Resolution to Governor Andrew M. Cuomo, Senate Temporary President and Majority Coalition Leader Dean Skelos, State Senators Greg Ball and Terry Gipson, Assembly Speaker Sheldon Silver, New York State Assemblymembers, Kevin Cahill,
